This sheet must be filled in and returned to the Form Teacher no later than **Friday 13 October 2023**.

Students not intending to return to Taieri College must also complete the form by ticking the appropriate box and having it signed.

While subject choice at this stage of the year is not binding, the number of classes, and staff allocation, are based on this return, and therefore this should be filled in as accurately as possible. Any changes that are necessary after this intention sheet is returned can be made only with the approval of the Year 10 Dean. Students should bring a signed note requesting the change, and give it to their form teacher to pass on to the Dean.

Two semesters each of English and Mathematics, and at least one semester each of Social Studies, Science and Physical Education continue to be compulsory subjects. Students are required to choose 5 other subjects (of 4 periods per week each for one semester). Although this can be a difficult decision, the wide choice of subjects in Year 9 should have allowed students to have a good basis for making this choice.

Students need to be aware of the subjects that are available in Year 11 & 12, and must take care that their choice of subjects does not limit their future course.

A booklet provided to all students contains information on all subjects available. Note that, in general, subjects only operate where there are sufficient students choosing that subject.
