<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. An annual plan is developed setting out how progress will be made toward the achievement of charter/strategic aims and targets and is approved by the board.2. The school curriculum is based on the vision, values, principles, and key competencies of the New Zealand Curriculum (or Te Marautanga o Aotearoa).3. The breadth and depth of learning related to the needs, abilities, and interests of students; the nature of the school's curriculum; and the scope of the national curriculum (as expressed in The New Zealand Curriculum or Te Marautanga o Aotearoa).4. There is a focus on the national priority groups of Māori, Pasifika, and students with special learning needs in school planning and reporting.5. Assessment practices enable the engagement, progress, and achievement of students to be monitored and reported.6. Board approval is sought before changes to the school curriculum requiring increased expenditure or significant changes to programmes or staffing are made.7. Appropriate career education and guidance is provided for all students, including specific guidance for students at risk of leaving school unprepared for work or further education
