PROTECTED DISCLOSURES POLICY

Rationale:	To provide information and guidance to employees of Taieri College who wish to report serious wrongdoing within Taieri College.
Legislation:	Protected Disclosures Act 2000 Education Act 1989 Human Rights Act 1993 Privacy Act 1993

A protected disclosure is a declaration made by an employee where they believe serious wrongdoing has occurred. Employees making disclosures will be protected against retaliatory or disciplinary action and will not be liable for civil or criminal proceedings related to the disclosure.

The Board of Trustees has a responsibility to have internal procedures for receiving and dealing with information about serious wrongdoing in or by Taieri College.

The Board of Trustees agrees that this Policy will be provided to all employees and will be reviewed at regular intervals.
